

God Give Me An Undivided Heart!

Ps 86:11 - Teach me your way, Lord, that I may rely on your faithfulness; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.

I. We need to pray like David prayed in Psalms 139:23-24!

Psalms 139:23-24 - "Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my thoughts; and see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting"

Proverbs 12:1 - Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is stupid.

II. We not only need to allow God to reveal sin in our life, but we need to agree with God about each area He shows us, confess it and repent of it!

III.. We need to live in the Word of God!

IV. We need to ask ourselves some questions and be honest about them!

1. Is all my trust in Christ?

Ps 37:3 - Trust (Put full confidence in/confide in fully) in the LORD and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture.

4. Delight yourself (be soft or pliable, melt in awe, faint Illus: reaction to Elvis) in the LORD and he will give you the desires (possession, that which makes you melt in awe) of your heart.

5. Commit your way to (Roll your way onto, come together, run down, seek out) the LORD; trust in him (Put full confidence in/confide in fully) and he will do this (work on your behalf):

2. "Have you ever genuinely repented?"

Ps. 37:4 - Delight yourself (be soft or pliable, melt in awe, grow faint because of admiration) in the LORD and he will give you the desires (possession, that which makes you melt in awe) of your heart.

3. Is Christ Lord of my life?

Ps. 37:5 - Commit your way to (Roll your way onto, come together, run down, seek out) the LORD; trust in him (Put full confidence in/confide in fully) and he will do this (work on your behalf):

Luke 6:46-49

46. "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?

47. I will show you what he is like who comes to me and hears my words and puts them into practice.

48. He is like a man building a house, who dug down deep and laid the foundation on rock. When a flood came, the torrent struck that house but could not shake it, because it was well built.

49. But the one who hears my words and does not put them into practice is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. The moment the torrent struck that house, it collapsed and its destruction was complete."

Matt. 7:21-23

21. "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

22. Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?'

23. Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!'
